The Trumbull County Senior Services Levy is a five-year, three-quarter mill property tax levy. It funds programs to enhance the well-being of Trumbull County adults age 60 and over.

Funds are made available through a public request for proposal (RFP) process. Funding recommendations are made by the commissioner-appointed Levy Advisory Council and are approved by the Trumbull County Board of Commissioners.
